Please enter by mailing entry to Cathy Gerhart, 45 Blackhorse Rd., Reinholds, PA 17569 and be postmarked or called in no later than Friday, August 27, 2010 **There is a \$2.00 a head entry fee.** Please mail to Deb Boyd 1655 Clay Rd., Ephrata, PA 17522. Make checks payable to Denver Fair. Must be postmarked by August 27, 2010. No entry fee, no show.
2. Entries are limited to: Sale goats - Cocalico, Ephrata and Garden Spot School Districts only. Non-sale goats - Lancaster, Lebanon and Berks Counties. Must be owned by June 1, 2010
3. American Dairy Goat Association official show rules shall govern this show. All goat show entries must have an official health certificate at time of entry Also animal owner/veterinarian certification of client/patient relationship. All goats must bear USDA/APHIS eartag except those having registration tattoos and a premise ID number.
4. Drugs administered to livestock prior to or during the fair for the purpose of controlling disposition or showmanship performance are prohibited
5. Bedding will be provided by the Denver Fair Inc. The feed, feed boxes and water buckets must be provided by the exhibitor who must see that animals are fed and cared for during the ENTIRE fair. Security guards will patrol the area
6. Arrival time and weigh in will be Monday, September 13 from 5:30 P.M.-7:00 P.M. All goats must weigh at least 70 pounds. There is no maximum weight
7. Sale class, one animal per exhibitor.
8. Non-sale class, limited to 2 animals per exhibitor.
9. Weigh classes to be set by chairperson
10. Denver Fair Committee reserves the right to limit space and quantity of entries. All local school districts will be considered first.
11. Removal and clean up time is Friday, September 17 after sale.
12. Sale will be Friday, September 17 at 6:00 P.M.
13. See department for housekeeping contest and awards.
