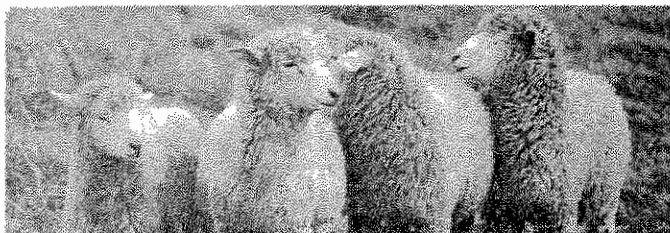

RULES:

1. Denver Sheep Show is open to all 4-H and FFA members in Lancaster and Berks Counties. All entries must be submitted by Friday, August 27. There is a \$2.00 a head entry fee. Please mail to Deb Boyd, 1655 Clay Rd., Ephrata, PA 17522. Make checks payable to: Denver Fair. Must be postmarked by August 27, 2010. No entry fee, no show.
2. Straw will be provided by the Denver Fair Committee. Each exhibitor must furnish his own feed and hay for the week of the fair. All animals must be fed daily.
3. Number of animals: There is a limit of 2 animals per exhibitor per class. Each exhibitor may exhibit a total of 6 sheep. This is a combination of market and breeding. Each exhibitor may exhibit 4 market lambs.
4. Denver Fair reserves the right to limit space and quantity of entries. All local school districts will be considered first.
5. Sheep Arrival Time: Monday, September 13, 2010 from 5:30 to 7:00 P.M. only. No exceptions will be made.
6. Sheep Show: Thursday, September 16, 2010 immediately following the goat show, which begins at 3:00 P.M. All exhibitors are expected to exhibit their own animals unless prior arrangements have been made with the show chairman.
7. Removal of Sheep: Friday, September 17, 2010 immediately following the livestock sale. All exhibitors are responsible for bringing proper equipment to help clean up and tear down their pens.
8. Anyone using artificial means to change the condition, form or shape of the animal will be disqualified from all classes in which they have entries at the discretion of the Sheep Show chairman.

HEALTH RULES:

1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after May 1, 2010 is required.
2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this required on the CVI.
3. An animal-owner or caretaker verification of veterinarian-client-patient relationship (VCPR) form must accompany each animal and must be presented upon arrival.
4. Individual official USDA scrapie animal ID is required. Official scrapie ID includes: USDA scrapie eartag, USDA approved custom scrapie eartag or USDA approved scrapie tattoo with individual animal ID or ISO compliant 15 digit eartag.
5. A current rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is required for animals 3 months and older (MARKET LAMBS ARE EXEMPT). All vaccine label directions must be followed and all rabies vaccinated sheep must be accompanied by a rabies vaccination certificate OR the vaccination information must be on the CVI. If a rabies vaccination certificate is provided, the certificate must be legible with the name and contact information of the veterinarian that administered the vaccination and the veterinarian's signature. A copy of the rabies vaccination certificate is acceptable.

SECTION 1 NON-SALE MARKET LAMBS

All market animals will be weighed upon arrival. All market lambs must be ewe lambs or wethers. No rams permitted. All lambs must weigh 80 pounds. There is no maximum weight.

SECTION 2 SALE MARKET LAMBS

All animals will be weighed and eartag upon arrival. All market lambs must be ewe lambs or wethers. No rams will be permitted. All lambs must weigh 80 pounds. There is no maximum weight. All exhibitors may sell one lamb on sale night, Friday September 17.
